Report by Mr. Baldwin, District Attorney:

- The Palm Beach County Information System Services has requested the District to enter into a written agreement for the services that they have traditionally provided in regards to the tax roll and certification. A final draft has been provided and will be submitted for the Board for approval.

- 4. We have removed the trees on the NC-1 canal and additional trees are to be removed.
- 5. Additional sod was placed on the NC-5 canal banks.
- 6. Adams Street residents have made applications for encroachment into the NC-1 canal easement on 6099 & 6327 Adams Street.
